Exercise 1

Don't forget to:

- choose 6 pictures for your illustrated article, put them in the right order and comment on every picture in 2-4 sentences;
- write a conclusion (you do not need a picture for a conclusion).

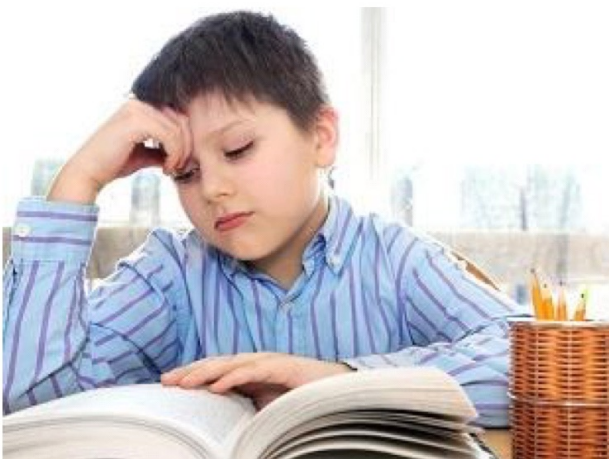
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
